Contents:

- a. In-depth articles: average to maximum length of 1000-2000 characters, providing the basic idea, commenting on, or illustrating some new item or event that bears on research in the area of Cicero or Roman thought.
- b. Notes: brief notices of average length (500-1000 characters) on conferences, research projects, calls for papers, and various announcements relating to the study of Cicero and Roman thought: 1-2 pages maximum.
- c. About Tulliana: notes and updates on the site and the society: very brief items, half page maximum.
- d. Reviews: brief texts (500 characters), accompanied by a photograph where appropriate, describing a publication, with a link to the larger review to be published in the section on Documents and Reviews in Tulliana (www.tulliana.eu): 1 page maximum.
- e. Friends of SIAC: information on partners, sister societies, and individual collaborators.
- f. New members: introduction and information concerning new members.
- g. Varia: non-academic articles, anecdotes, etc.
- h. My Cicero: ideas, suggestions, proposals inspired by Cicero's person and works.

Where not explicitly indicated, contents will vary according to the topic at hand.
